Ages 10-13: gift certificate

Ages 14-17: bursary offered by the Centre linguistique du Collège de Jonquière

Rules:

All poems should be submitted by post or emailed by 8:00pm on Friday May 12th, 2017

There are two categories: 10-13 years and 14-17 years.

Poems must have a limit of 20 lines or less,

Only one entry per student can be submitted.

The contest is open to students aged 10 to 17 years that are registered in an English school board in Quebec.

Students may enter individually and not through a school. Proof of English school board registration might be requested if necessary.

Students may choose the theme and form.

Entries should be typed or neatly hand-written
